The Youth Livestock Auction will look different this year. The auction committee is committed to helping 4-H and FFA members of Yamhill County sell their animals.

Buyer and Add-On Donor Registration:

Auction Site for Bidding & Add-Ons: <https://bid.virtualstockshow.com>

Use Firefox or Google Chrome web browser.

Registration will be open 3-5 days before auction day. Buyers will be asked for a contact name, company name if applicable, mailing address, email, and a cell phone number that can receive calls and texts during and immediately following the live auction.

Auction Process:

The auction will occur in two parts:

1. Silent auction preview and pre-bid - The online auction platform will open for a silent auction and pre-bid on Wednesday, July 29th at 5:00pm PDT. Buyers will be able to place initial bids, maximum bids and pledge add-ons. The silent portion of the sale will close at 11:30am on Saturday, August 1st.
2. Live auction – The live auction will begin on Saturday, August 1st. at 12:00 pm. Buyers will log into the auction site : <https://bid.virtualstockshow.com> and participate in real time with a live auctioneer. Bids for each lot will begin at either the minimum bid or the most recent silent bid, whichever is greater.

Animals will be sold on a per head basis.

Starting bid per head: Hogs - \$600 - Steers \$2500 - Turkeys \$200 - Rabbits \$200 per pen

Chickens \$200 per pen - Goats \$500 - Sheep \$500

Re-Sale/Floor Price will be published the day of auction.

4-H and FFA members will be listed alphabetically by species.

Sale order will start with Hogs, followed by Steers, Turkeys, Rabbits, Chickens, Goats and Sheep.

The winning bidder will receive a text message following the close of each lot that will verify resale/floor or keep. If buyer is keeping the animal, you will also be asked where you would like it processed or if you want to donate to local food bank.

Buyers may be contacted by a committee member to verify purchase(s) and instructions on the day of or after the sale.

Buyer Payment Options:

Credit Card with an added convenience fee of 3.5% (you will be contacted by a committee member for credit card information)

Check payable to Yamhill County Livestock Association and mailed to P.O. Box 242, Carlton, OR 97111.

Invoice(s) will also be sent out.

Add-Ons Only: Add-Ons can be conducted two ways:

1. Registering at the auction website: <https://bid.virtualstockshow.com> Use the drop-down menu.
2. Mail payment and included form to: P.O. Box 242, Carlton, OR 97111 by August 1st.
